Dear Chairman Parisi:

Pursuant to the Town Charter, Chapter III, Section 9, I hereby certify that a sufficient number of qualified signatures have signed a Petition for the Repeal of Town Council's resolution on August 9, 2011 approving Lease Agreements of the parking lots at 2-26 North Main Street, 36-40 North Main Street, 60 North Main Street and 48-50 North Main Street. The required number of signatures is 2,491 and the petitioners obtained 2,634 signatures.

Pursuant to Chapter III, Section 9, the Town Council has thirty days to repeal its action of August 9, 2011. If the matter is not repealed by the Council, I propose that the election in accordance with the Town Charter and State laws, be scheduled for November 14, 2011.

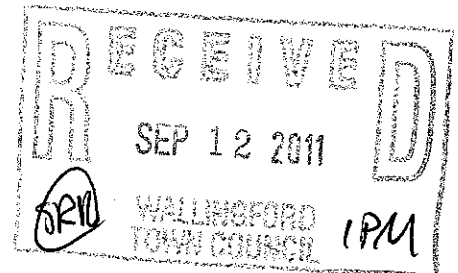
Pursuant to State law, the referendum cannot be placed on the ballot for November 8, 2011. Connecticut General Statutes §9-370 prohibits the question from being added to the ballot within sixty (60) days of the election.

Attached is the proposed question for the November 14, 2011 referendum which has been approved by the Town Attorney.
